

NEHCA Spring Show Suggested Show

Packing Checklist:

Mandatory Equipment Checklist:

- Rope Halter & Necktie (1x each animal)
- Feed Buckets
- Water Buckets
- Hay, Feed (*Tip: always bring one more bale than you think you need*)
- Hose, hose nozzle
- Manure Wheelbarrow
- Manure Fork
- Broom
- 2+ Power Extension Cords
- Scotch comb
- Pocket knife/ Scissors
- Animal Identification Name Plate for Each Animal
 - Listing: Registered Name, AHCA Reg# (if applicable), DOB, Sire, Dam, Owner, find a sign template on the NEHCA Spring Show page on website!

If Showing Bulls Over 12+ Months of Age:

- Nose Ring
- Nose Lead Strap

Optional Equipment Checklist:

- Fan (*highly* suggested if the temperature is above 70°F at the show- we have used house box fans for years!)
- Grooming Chute (*highly* suggested)
- Stall Divider (*highly* suggested)
- Display Curtains w/ Clothesline to hang curtains
- Farm Sign/Banner
- Farm Display Folding Table & Table Cloth, curtains
 - Farm Business Cards
 - Display Items: *have fun with this one!*
 - Picture frames with farm photos- suggest no glass!
 - Knickknacks/display items, ex: flower pots, highland skull
- Bag Chairs, cooler (for humans) make yourself comfortable!
- Zip ties/ duct tape

Wash Rack Bucket:

- Small bucket to hold wash rack supplies- *highly suggested*
 - Scrub Brush (plastic bristles for scrubbing body)
 - Rice Root Brush (hard bristles for scrubbing hoofs)
 - Shampoo (drugstore brand is fine!)
- Hose
- Nose Nozzle (wash rack water pressure courtesy)
- Sullivan Scotch Comb
 - Metal Comb:** Great at wash rack to remove hair knots
 - Plastic Comb:** Great for grooming chute & styling hair

Grooming Chute Supplies: you do not need a grooming chute to exhibit at a show

- Cattle Blow Dryer (*highly* suggested)
- Scotch comb (metal or plastic)
- Baby wipes (clean ears, eye crusties, nose, equipment)
- Scissors

Show Ring Supplies

Show Ring Equipment:

- Leather Show Halter
- Show Stick
- Number Bib/ Number Clip: *check the show requirement*
- Plastic Show Comb

Show Ring Clothing: Clean Clothes at the Start of Show

- Collared Shirt (can be long or short sleeve)
 - Clothing cannot have *any* farm names/logos
- Padded or Canvas Vest (*highly* suggested, extra protection if handling horned cattle)
- Black or Dark Wash Bootcut Jeans (no rips or holes)
- Boots (Cowboy or Work Boots)
- Belt
- No baseball caps/hats in ring
