

## 2023 NEHCA SPRING SHOW GENERAL RULES FOR ALL ANIMALS

## May 5-7<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Eastern States Exposition- West Springfield, MA

## **Animal Health Requirements:**

- 1. All animals must be in proper physical condition, be properly identified and free of visual evidence of infectious, contagious, or parasitic disease at time of arrival. Animals of any species with open or draining wounds will not be approved for entry.
- 2. Show cattle: Must have
  - a. RFID Tag.
  - b. State or federal health certificate.
  - c. Brucellosis and TB testing not required for cattle from TB accredited and Brucellosis-free states, otherwise Brucellosis and TB testing within 30 days of show.
  - d. Shipping fever within 30 days
  - e. Rabies vaccinations before 30 days are suggested.
